

on Paula and David Solomon

So far, we have raised nearly £2000 for MNDA since David was diagnosed on 6th October 2015. Being diagnosed with Motor Neurone Disease was one of the worst experiences of our lives, we decided early on that this is not going to beat us, we are in this together.

We decided fairly early on after diagnosis to get married, it was something that we had planned to do, but hadn't got round to organising. On July 22nd 2016 we got married at Northampton Guildhall. It was a very special day for us both surrounded by our close friends and family. We followed this by a big party with all of our friends two weeks later, David organised the party in true David style, there were Hula Dancers, Belly Dancers, Karaoke, disco and BBQ, everybody had a fantastic evening.



Some events that we have taken part in to raise the £2000 are:

We both ran the Manchester Marathon

Two weeks later we both started the London Marathon, unfortunately David fell on a discarded water bottle and was advised not to continue. I carried on and finished.

Followed it with a marathon in Cambridge two weeks later

Then walked from London to Brighton in 22.5 hours all within eight weeks. Our Running club, Northampton Road Runners, have been really supportive.

In March we raised around £800 by selling cakes and hot sausage rolls after our annual run, I have sold items at car boot sales that have been donated by friends and family, we also hosted a beetle bingo afternoon which was so much fun.

I am also planning to run in the Bournemouth Marathon on 2nd October, and have signed up for the Cotswold challenge 100km walk July 2017. Our motto is "one life live it" and we certainly do!!
